Trees of Christmas Future at LI

The goal of Lyndon Institute's Diversified Agriculture program, taught by instructors Jerry Leonard and Rob Heath, is to expose students to a wide range of topics. "We try to hit on as many types of agricultural practices as possible," said Heath. "The days of focusing on small dairy farming are over. We've worked hard on branching out to explore different kinds of operations our students might someday wish to pursue—things like agrotourism, maple sugaring, operating food stands—either as full-time businesses or as seasonal hobbies and supplementary income streams."

One part of this goal has involved including more forestry units in the program. Students have recently begun harvesting select pines from the forest behind the school, learning logging and tractor safety practices in the process.

Now, the program can add Christmas trees to the list.

"Right now, the trees are growing in raised beds," Heath explained. "Next spring, we'll transplant them into their permanent home."

That home will be an area of land donated by the Elliott family in 2015 along the Passumpsic River behind what used to be the Lynburke Motel.

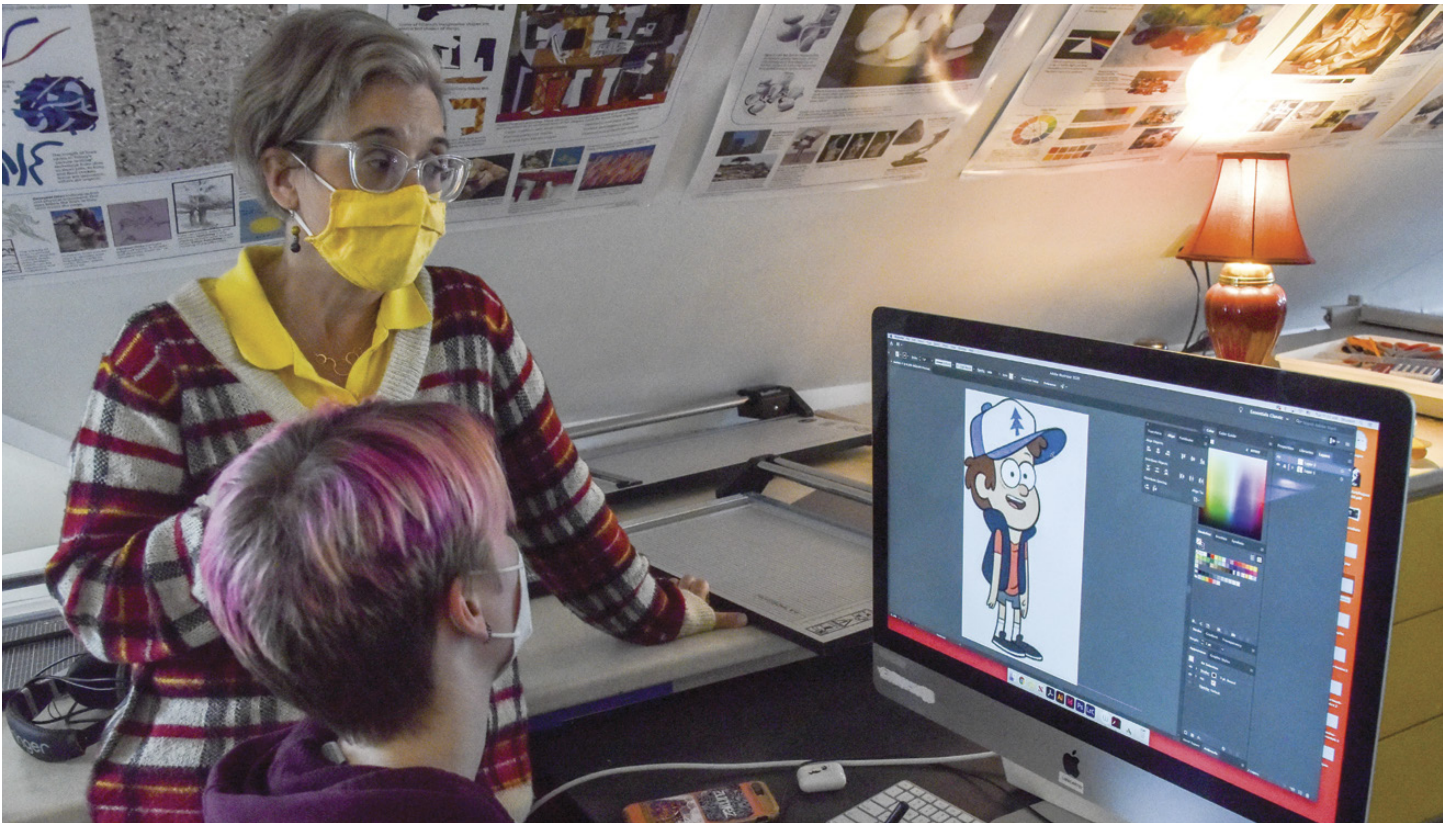
Students will each be assigned eight to ten trees a year to care for. Every new class will plant more trees until the lot reaches its maximum capacity, and eventually, new saplings will begin to replace harvested trees. Staggering the planting this way will allow students to learn how to tend to the trees at every stage of growth—from planting to trimming to harvesting.

The project was made possible in part with a generous donation from LI alum Ed Buschmann, who has been a strong supporter of the Diversified Ag program—and LI's Career and Technical Education program in general—throughout the years.

Designing for the Future

Lyndon Institute's Career and Technical Education Department isn't just about being in the classroom, it's about learning to succeed in a professional setting by providing as much real-world, project-based experience as possible. Nowhere is that seen more clearly than in the school's Graphic Design Program.

In the late 90s, LI expanded its traditional visual arts offerings by hiring local artist Ellen Levitt, who was able to bring her talents as a professional designer into the classroom with courses in surface design, printmaking, and book arts. The opening of the Norris Center for the Arts on lower campus in the early 2000s brought the arrival of a new studio featuring a state-of-the-art Mac lab and new courses in digital design. In recent years, Bridget Atkins, Levitt's successor, has expanded the program even further, providing students with an opportunity to learn what it's like to work in a professional design studio.

Students who complete the program come away with marketable credentials, including Adobe certifications in Photoshop and Illustrator, and can also parlay their time in the program into college credit, giving them a leg up if they choose to continue their education at the post-secondary level. Lyndon Institute's articulation agreement with Northern Vermont University allows students who enroll at NVU to transfer their Graphic Design Program coursework into four three-credit classes. Students also have the option of applying their two free Vermont State Dual Enrollment vouchers to turn their coursework into college credit, as well as two additional "Fast Forward" dual enrollment vouchers they receive through being part of the state-certified CTE program. Either route provides students with nearly a full semester's worth of college credits.

New Board President Assists in Head of School Transition

Twenty-five years after her own graduation from Lyndon Institute, new Board of Trustees President Lorealee Tester has been at the forefront of welcoming the 21st Head of School, Dr. Brian Bloomfield, to the community.

The transition from the 20th to the 21st Head of School this coming summer will be one orchestrated not only by Tester but by the Board and school community as a whole.

“Lorealee and I meet on a regular basis and coordinate the information being shared with Dr. Bloomfield,” says current Head of School Twiladawn Perry. Tester adds, “I couldn’t be prouder of my fellow board members in hiring Dr. Bloomfield. We are at a time and place where education and expectations are being transformed. We are now ready to embrace Dr. Bloomfield’s leadership as he brings new strengths and experience to our school and region.”

Though Tester is excited for Dr. Bloomfield’s leadership, she’s grateful for the job Perry, herself an alum of the Class of 1977, has done since assuming the role as Head of School five years ago. “Twila has seen the school through some incredible challenges.”

Reflecting on her thirty-nine years of service to the school, Perry credits her time working under Dwight Davis as life-changing. “As a mentor, he gave me the confidence to develop my leadership skills. Then, working as the Career and Technical Education director, I came to understand that our CTE students needed the same skills as our college prep students as they moved into the workforce.” Looking ahead to the future, Perry comments, “In July, Dr. Bloomfield should have a school with a balanced budget and a steady enrollment to work with. As Board Chair, Lorealee should not have significant short-term issues but can focus on the more interesting, long-term issues of the school.”

Tester continues to extend her and the entire Board’s gratitude and well wishes to Perry for her many years of dedication and service. “We know that her work in supporting the people of the Northeast Kingdom is not ending, but a new chapter is beginning. I am grateful to the Board’s deep commitment to ensuring Twila’s legacy is continued by Brian. As a Board, we promise to support him in every way as he leads the school into the future.”

Honoring Tradition While Celebrating the Future

A million dollar campaign for Lyndon Institute

Founded in 1867, Lyndon Institute is dedicated to providing a unique educational experience for our students that leads to a lifetime of learning and good citizenship. We are an independent and comprehensive high school located in the heart of the Northeast Kingdom and rely heavily on the generosity of donors to make vital improvements. While we may be independent in governance, our mission is very much a public one, dedicated to serving the greater good of our community. Thirty-five percent of our students are eligible for special education services; thirty-five percent, as well, are eligible for free and reduced lunch. Our local Career and Technical Education center is vital to ensuring our non-college-bound students leave with valuable work skills they can use locally.

Built in 1922 after a fire destroyed the original building on the site, Lyndon Institute's Main Building is approaching its one hundredth birthday. It is positioned atop a long sloping hill on campus, and its large windows, bell tower, and distinctive fluted columns represent a prominent and instantly recognizable symbol of our school. Our beloved Main Building will celebrate its 100th birthday on December 21, 2022 and is deserving of some upgrades and attention to preserve its regal stature in celebration of this significant milestone.

In 2018, Lyndon Institute participated in a state-wide security assessment of schools to evaluate emergency preparedness strengths and identify areas for future school safety planning, training, and resource needs. One of the areas identified for immediate improvement was the installation of security cameras and key readers, which we quickly implemented.

However, even with the added security improvements, the current layout of our main building poses a security risk. Our reception area, located in the forty-five-year-old Pierce Wing, does not have a clear view of the parking lot or entrance walkway, nor does the current configuration provide a full view of those entering the building.

The Need:

- A new and inviting entrance by the cafeteria will create more efficient traffic flow into the Main Building and will provide an updated welcoming space. The entrance will be aesthetically pleasing being designed to compliment the distinctive columned entrance on the front of the school.
- The reception area will be moved in front of the existing entrance which will greatly improve the building's security, providing increased visibility in multiple directions.
- Restrooms located inside the new entry will be redesigned to be single use, gender neutral units. This redesign will greatly reduce the amount of supervision needed in this area. It will also provide gender neutral bathroom options in the Main Building.
- The student lounge area will feature modern furniture which complement the historical elements of the original building, allowing students to customize their arrangement allowing greater flexibility from traditional furniture. The space will feature charging stations and art walls that will be regularly updated with current student art.
- The Main Building retains its original single-paned windows on the front of the school—since 1922 only the opening mechanisms have changed, along with the replacement of individual panes and repainting and reglazing as needed—and the old wood is reaching a state that makes continued use hazardous. On the advice of multiple contractors and the experienced Maintenance team at LI, this project was highlighted as an urgent need to be addressed as soon as possible. In June of 2016, work commenced to replace the windows on the rear and side of the building, leaving the front of the building still needing to be completed. Despite the use of storm windows, the heat loss in the winter constitutes a significant expense for the school, not to mention the environmental impacts created by overuse of heating oil.

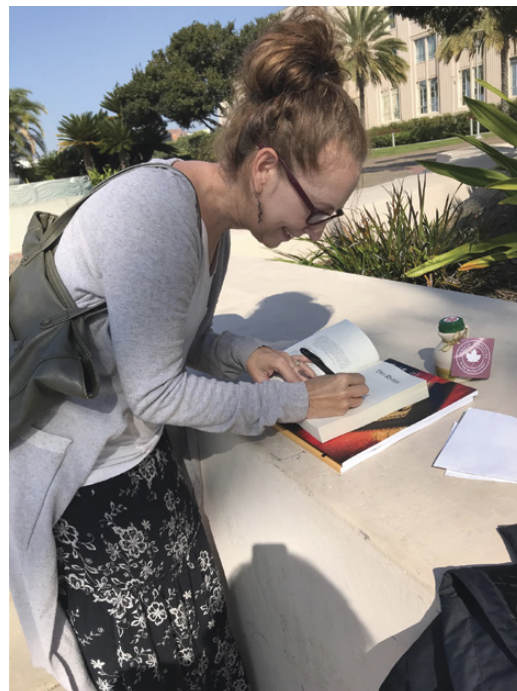
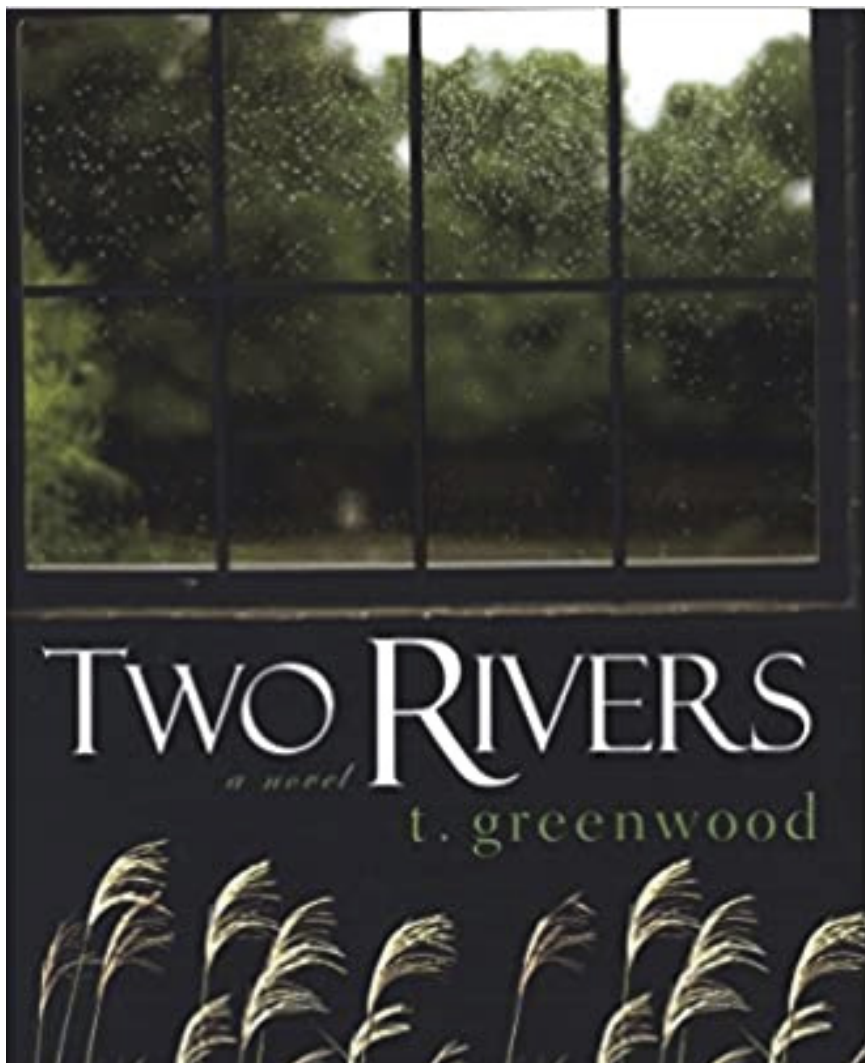
Alumni Book Club

Athletics

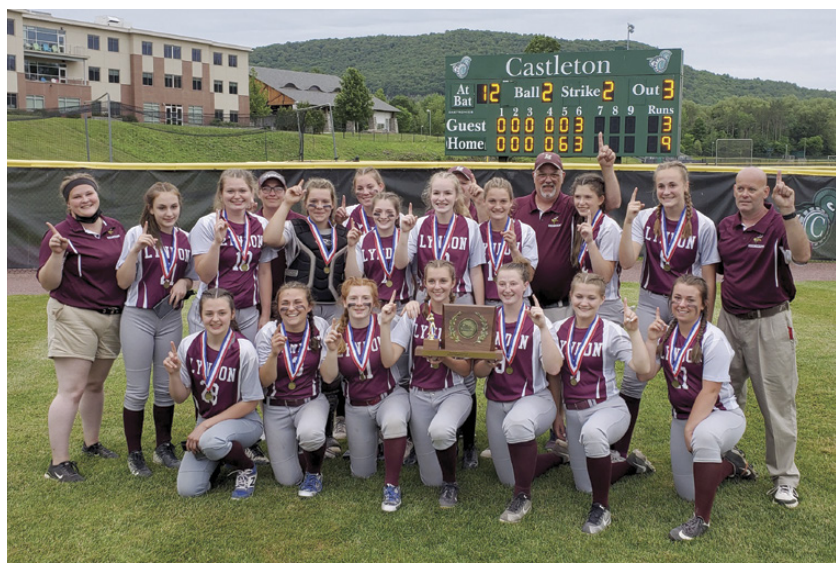

The Institute's campus is situated on 130 acres in the Northeast Kingdom of Vermont near Burke Mountain. The Institute offers a traditional college preparatory program with a variety of options for Career & Technical Education as well as dual enrollment with local colleges Northern Vermont University and Community College of Vermont. The curriculum is geared toward helping students prepare for whatever they pursue after receiving their high school diploma, whether that be a traditional four-year degree, a two-year degree, a professional training or apprenticeship, or entrance into the workforce. During its 130 years, the Institute has produced generous benefactors; championships in sports, music, drama, and academics; and active alumni. Today, with an enrollment of approximately 445 students, and 110 employees, the Institute serves Lyndon and approximately a half dozen nearby communities.



Corporate Governance Information:

The corporation, Lyndon Institute, shall consist of not less than fifty (50) and not more than one hundred fifty (150) corporators. The corporators' terms of office, being three (3) years, are ordered so that no more than fifty (50) corporators are eligible for election at any given annual meeting.

Lyndon Institute is governed by its independent Board of Trustees. The Lyndon Institute Board of Trustees is elected by the corporators from eligible members of the corporation, that is, corporators who have served in that capacity for at least one year. At the annual meeting of the corporation, a Board of twenty-one (21) members is elected. Commencing after the September 2009 annual meeting elections, a Trustee's term of office will be limited to three (3) three-year consecutive terms, i.e., a total of nine consecutive years. This term limit starts after the conclusion of the Trustee's current term. A Trustee may then be eligible for re-nomination to the Board of Trustees one year after his/her nine consecutive year term has expired.

Operating Overview:

For the 2020-2021 school year, the surplus or increase in net assets from operating activities was just over \$480,000. This translates to an approximate \$540,000 cash surplus that will be used to fund reserves. Our overall net assets increased by over \$4.6M, which can be most significantly attributed to investment earnings, forgiveness of the PPP loan by the SBA, and positive operations.



Endowment Overview:

The beginning balance of the endowment was \$8.1M. There were disbursements of \$38,000 and our annual spending policy drawdown of \$262,000, combined with receipts of \$583,000, fees of \$48,000, and overall earnings of over \$2.0M, all resulting in the fiscal year end balance of \$10.6M.

Director's Report:

Lyndon Institute's endowment is critical to sustaining the School's excellence in perpetuity. Income from endowed funds provides support to student scholarships, programs, and other designations, helping the school offset the rising costs of tuition to meet current operating budget priorities.

Endowments are:

- charitable funds that offer a source of stability.
- critical to the financial health of schools.
- essential to support our work to offer high-quality, affordable, accessible education.
- Not a single fund, but a compilation of funds given by many donors over time, for specific purposes.

The school has 94 funds within our endowment. \$32,035 in scholarships were awarded in 2021.
